Exhibition Conditions:

- **Entry forms must be received at the gallery by Fri 13 Nov.**
- **Delivery of work is on Fri 20 Nov or Sat 21 Nov between 10am - 1pm.** If unable to deliver on these days, please email the gallery or ring Annemarie on 0413 247 237 to make arrangements for an **earlier** delivery. **No works** will be accepted after 1pm on Sat 21 Nov.
- **Collection of unsold work** on **Tue 26 Jan and Wed 27 Jan from 10am to 12 noon.** If unable to collect at these times, please contact the gallery to make alternative arrangements.
- **No entry fees are charged to Alpine Artists, members of the Bright Art Gallery - membership must be paid up for 2021 at time of delivery.** Membership to the Bright Art Gallery is \$15 per calendar year. Membership form may be delivered and paid for, when delivering work. To pay online please refer to the Gallery website: www.brightartgallery.org.au
- Works entered must be original work by the artist. No copies of other artists work. All works must be for sale (except for P-12 students work). The gallery reserves the right to reject any unsuitable entries. The selling price shall include a commission of 25% to the gallery. It may not be possible to display all works entered at the beginning of the exhibition, depending on the number of artists entering. Therefore, we ask you to list your works in order of your preference to be exhibited, first listed the most important etc. It is the intention to group each artist's works together. Please provide a CV if you can.
- **Two-dimensional hanging art works:** Paintings, Photographs, Drawings, Handmade prints, Fabric, Leadlight, Mosaic wall-hangings – any subject, any medium, traditional or contemporary, framed works or unframed stretched canvasses. All works are to be suitably presented with D-rings and hanging wires attached, ready for hanging (no protruding hooks/screws, no fencing wire please!). Each work must be clearly labeled on the back with artist's name, title of work, medium and selling price. **Maximum 8 entries** in total per artist with no more than 4 large works (large is 1-4 m²).
- **Three-dimensional standing art works:** Ceramics, Glassware, Sculpture, Wearable Art, Leadlight, Woodwork, Mosaic etc (indoor & outdoors) - original artefacts only, handmade by the artist. All items are to be entered on the artist entry form with a description and selling price for each item. The artist is to attach labels/stickers with artist initials & price to each item. **Maximum 15 pieces per artist**, a set of mugs/ bowls etc priced as a set is one entry.
- **Small items, Jewellery, Silverware, Beading.** A maximum of **30 items** per artist. All items must be listed individually on entry form and delivered to the gallery with labels/stickers attached with artist initials and price.
- **Sold items** may be replaced by the artist with new work during the exhibition. Replacement items must be listed on an additional entry form with each new delivery.
- You have an opportunity to have your work represented on the Bright Art Gallery's website <https://www.brightartgallery.org.au/art-for-sale/>. To be included please submit **good quality digital photographs in JPG format** of your artwork. Please **CROP** your photo to include **only** the painting (no background) or for 3-dimensional work to only show the work with plain/minimal background. **RENAME photos before sending in, as follows:** Surname,FirstName-Title-Medium-Size-Price. Only photos submitted as per above guidelines will be processed.

- The gallery is run and managed by **volunteers** only, your help in manning the front or sales desk is much appreciated. Exhibiting artists are encouraged to sit in the gallery as many times as they can during the exhibition. Front desk duties consist of greeting visitors and providing general information about the exhibition. If you feel confident, you might want to take on the sales desk. Both positions provide an excellent opportunity to network and talk to prospective buyers of your work. A roster will be available to fill in at delivery time. It is **not** a condition for exhibiting work, to volunteer at the gallery.
- Artist payments for sales (except cards) in Dec will be processed in January. All further sales in January will be processed within one month of the conclusion of the exhibition.
